
About CenterPoint Energy.

- Advanced logistics network, including world-class highway, rail and port systems;
- Certified sites, which ensure a streamlined permitting and building process; and
- Existing supply chains in key industries such as agriculture, automotive, aerospace, pharmaceutical, plastics and glass.

Business-friendly environment

- The Dayton region's population has grown 4.5% in the past 10 years and is home to three of Ohio's top ten universities (Forbes Magazine in 2015).
- Ohio is ranked third in the nation for business climate (Site Selection Magazine 2016) and has a \$1.4 billion budget surplus.
- Indiana has a AAA bond rating from all three rating agencies and is ranked first in government efficiency (2017 U.S. News).
- Indiana is ranked second in the nation for cost of doing business (CNBC) and has the best regulatory environment in the nation (Pacific Research Institute).
